Margaret (Mimi) Cunningham is Vice President of Grand Hotel, a 385-room historic hotel built in 1887 on Michigan's Mackinac Island, where no motorized vehicles are permitted. Along with her brother Dan Musser, III, Mimi is part of the third generation of Musser family ownership and operation of Grand Hotel, the world's largest summer resort.

Mimi is responsible for the management and buying for all Grand Hotel shops. This includes ten shops in the Hotel ranging from clothing and souvenirs to flowers, jewelry and art galleries. In addition, she takes on various food service and special event responsibilities.

Since joining Grand Hotel full time in 1984, Mimi has held a variety of positions to gain a thorough understanding of all aspects of the Hotel. She held positions in housekeeping, food and beverage, hotel shops and convention sales. Before Grand Hotel, she worked at The Ritz Carleton in Boston.

Mimi received a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Kenyon College in Gambier, Ohio in 1982. She lives on Mackinac Island during the season and in East Lansing, Michigan the rest of the year.
